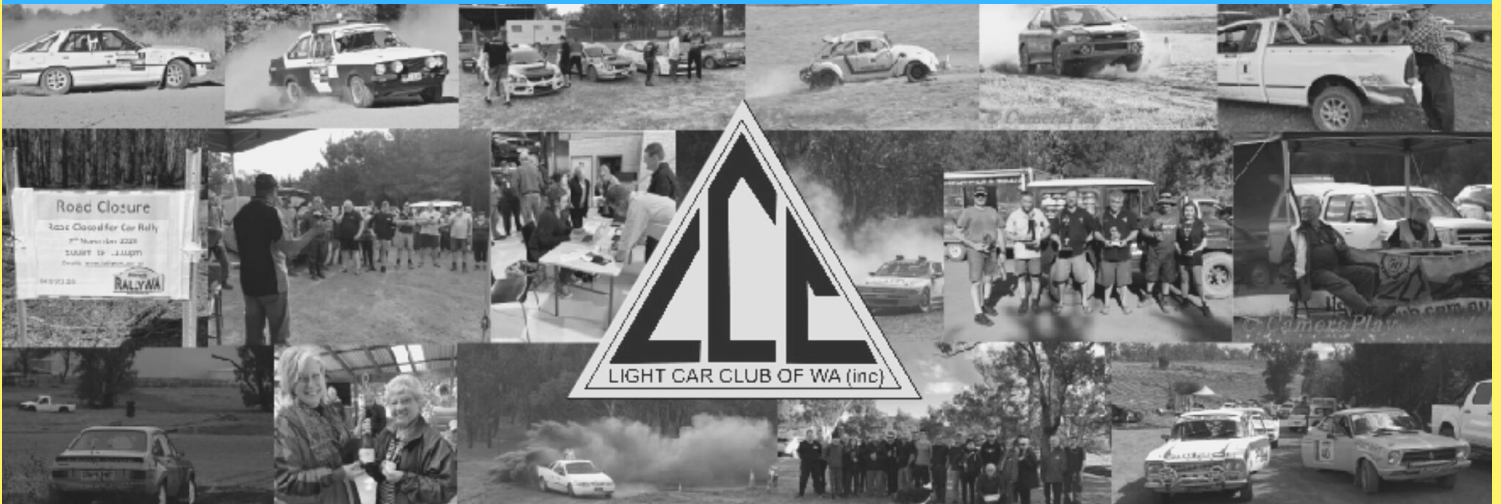

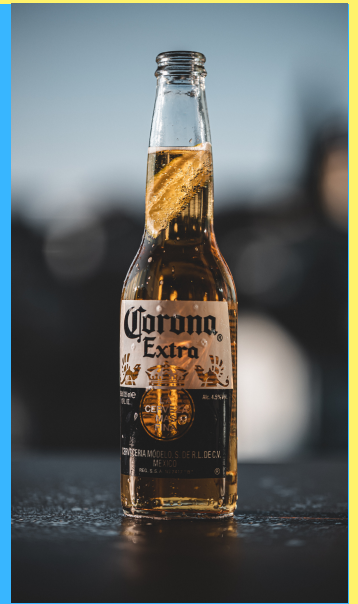
July's Superior Customs Round 2 Khanacross
