1. ORGANISATION

- The Motorsport Australia Rally Standing Regulations Special Stage Rallies (SSR)
- The Rally Standing Regulations Vehicles General (VG)
- The Rally Standing Regulations Events General (EG)
- The Motorsport Australia Rallysprint Standing Regulations (RSSR)
- These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

2. ENTRIES

Entries may only be made by using the Motorsport Australia online entry system via the Motorsport Australia member portal.

Documentation forms to be emailed to: events@lightcarclub.com.au

Crew members will consist of two persons and must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Rally (Drivers), or a Rally Junior (Co-Drivers) competition licence.

The minimum age for Drivers and Co-Drivers in a Rallysprint is 14 years.

2.1 Entry Fee

The maximum number of entries will be 40, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Minimum 15 entries

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The Event Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$100 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries. NO REFUND will be granted for entries withdrawn after 3rd October 2025.

2.2 Event Details

The event will be held on closed unsealed roads over 1 stage of 5.8 km run 2 x times in both directions.

The Official Notice Board will be located online at www.lightcarclub.com.au prior to the event and at Event HQ during the event.

Competitors shall line up from the assembly area at the stage start in order. Competing vehicles will start on two-minute intervals. Competitors must run the entire stage without deviating from the course and complete it through the flying finish. Competitors must then significantly reduce speed and stop at the designated point for recording their stage time.

2.3 Documentation & Scrutiny

Scrutiny shall be conducted on the day within the designated assembly area.

Competitors must present the following items to the pre-event documentation check.

- Motorsport Australia Licence for Driver and Co-Driver
- Current MA affiliated Car Club Membership Card for Driver and Co-Driver
- Civil Driving Licence for Both Crew Members (not required if Co-Driver has a navigator only licence)
- Motorsport Australia Vehicle Logbook

3. Vehicle Eligibility

Each Automobile shall comply with Motorsport Australia Rally Standing Regulations – Vehicles General

4. Timing & Results

Timing shall be to the **tenth of a second.**

The winner of each competition within the event shall be the competitor who achieves the lowest aggregate elapsed time. The aggregate elapsed time shall be calculated by adding together the results for each crew from each run of each stage of the event (inclusive of penalties).

All stage runs shall count towards the aggregate time. Results will be published on the Light Car Club of WA's website once finalised.

4.1 Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for:

- First 4WD
- First 2WD
- First Junior 14-17 yrs old
- Last Place

4.2 Presentation

A awards presentation will be held immediately after the event.

5. PROTEST

Any protests lodged must be in accordance with the NCR.

6. INTEGRITY

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and "vaping") and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy. Motorsport Australia's Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia. Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
