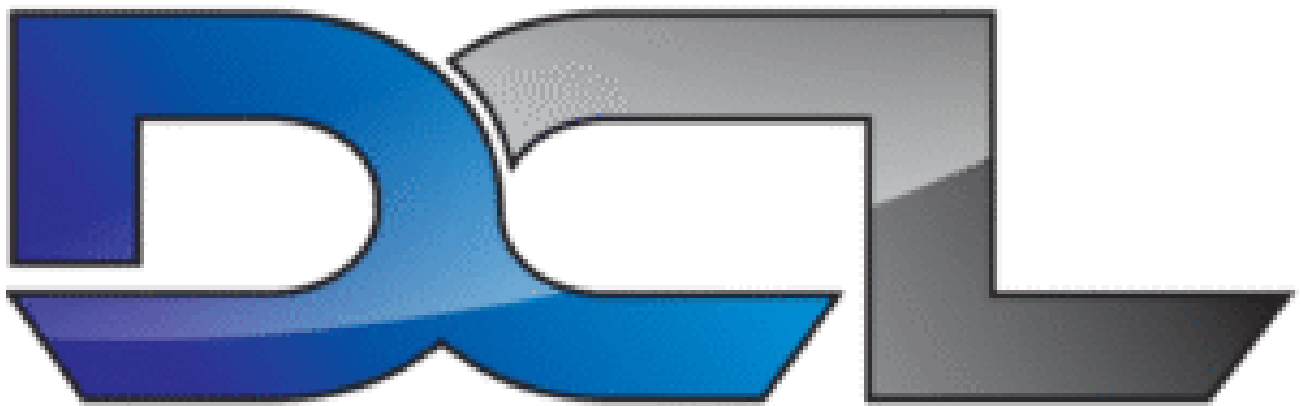

- These Supplementary Regulations, any Further Regulations and any authorised Bulletins which may be issued.

This Event will be conducted held in accordance with Motorsport Australia's Occupational Health and Safety Policy, Integrity Policies, Legal Policies, Risk Management Policies, Safety 1st Framework and any other relevant Policy.

Crew members must hold a minimum of a Motorsport Australia Rally (Drivers), or a Rally Junior (Co-Drivers) competition licence.

The maximum number of entries will be 70, with entries accepted in order of receipt.

Entries may be refused in accordance with the NCR.

The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Event in accordance with the NCR.

As per the NCR the entry fee must be received in full prior to the close of entries. A full refund will only be issued when a competitor withdraws, in writing, from the event prior to the close of entries. A \$150 administration fee will apply to a withdrawal received after the close of entries and prior to reconnaissance being completed. A \$350 fee will apply to withdrawals after reconnaissance and prior to scrutiny. NO REFUND will be granted for entries withdrawn after Tuesday 25TH August 2026.

2.2 Event Details

The Official Notice Board will be located online at www.rallywa.com and/or during Rally HQ opening hours at the RallyWA Results Van (Jim Mc Donald Oval Southwest Highway, Kirup).

Bonus points will be allocated as per the MAWARCS SSR Article H2 (vi) on SS6.

2.3 Documentation and Scrutiny

Competitor documentation (licenses, permits etc) are to be submitted electronically to Safari@lightcarclub.com.au before close of entries date.

Scrutiny will be undertaken as per MAWARCS SSR F7 Event Scrutiny (Selected).

Event stickers and road books can be collected by competitors as per the Event Programme.

Location and time of scrutiny are shown in the Event Programme and a Bulletin with the selected vehicles and times will be issued.

3. RALLYSAFE

Rally safe is compulsory for ALL competitors. Rally safe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact in relation to vehicle speed, location and "Push to Pass" notification.

All competitors are to have a full Rally safe Fitting Kit installed prior to scrutiny and it must be powered from a permanent power source. There are available from Rally Safe

If a "Push to Pass" is received on the Rally Safe unit, as soon as practical, you must safely allow the car following to pass. Failure to do so may result in a referral to the Stewards where an infringement may be applied. Rally Safe data is deemed to be a Judge of Fact for "Push to Pass" notification.

All cars must present to the Rally Safe "Tech Zone" at least 10 minutes prior to their due time at TC0. A final check of the Rally Safe unit, location, cables, connections, aerial position, power, and connectivity will take place to ensure it is working correctly.

4. AWARDS & PRESENTATION

A provisional awards presentation will be held to celebrate the 60th Safari and winners immediately after the Event. 2 x Dinner tickets are included and is strongly encouraged all competitors to attend extra tickets available and rsvp by end of scrutineering.

Clubman Cup awards presentation will occur after the last Clubman Cup crew finish. WARC awards presentation will occur after the last WARC crew finish.

5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING

- A. The Service Park for the event will be located at Jim McDonald Oval Southwest Highway Kirup. Service Vehicles may be parked in the Service Park overnight. The Organisers take no responsibility for any vehicles.
- B. No fuel is available at Kirup. The Refuel will be located within the Service Park. Service crews are to comply with the apparel requirements and to follow the directions of Rally Officials.
- C. Cars may only be washed by use of a sponge from a bucket. Where oils, solvents and degreasing fluids are used all residues must be securely contained and prevented from coming into contact with the ground. The use of pressure cleaners is prohibited. Breaches noted by an Official of the Rally will be reported to the Stewards with a recommendation that a fine be applied.
- D. No service vehicle may drive on a competitive stage during the running of the Event without the express permission of the Clerk of the Course. If vehicle recovery is required, service crews are to contact the Competitor Relations Officer or Rally HQ for instruction.
- E. To be covered by the Motorsport Australia Personal Accident Insurance, service crew members must be registered with the Organisers by the close of Documentation Verification.
- F. The entire service park is a designated "Non-smoking" area.

6. RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will be available as per the event schedule.

Competitors are reminded that speed is restricted to 60kmh during reconnaissance. Penalties will apply for any breaches which may incur a time penalty to be applied to the competition.

7. ODOMETER CHECK

Odometer check will be located on the first liaison section from TC0.

The start of the odometer check can be found in the road book. Crews can follow the roadbook from the event start to the Odometer check.

8. PROTEST

Any protests lodged must be in accordance with the NCR.

9. ROOKIES

All Rookies should advise the Event Secretary that they are eligible for the Rookie Award by emailing safari@lightcarclub.com.au prior to the start of the event.

10. INTEGRITY

Smoking Including e-cigarettes and vaping, and any naked flame is prohibited within (3) metres of any refuelling or defueling operation or within the paddock.

Motorsport Australia's National Integrity Framework and relevant Integrity Policies, including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, and the Alcohol Policy apply to any activity sanctioned by Motorsport Australia.

Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.
